The first versions of AutoCAD did not use GDS (2D), or GDS 2 (2.5D), file formats. Instead, all drawings created in AutoCAD could be directly saved as proprietary formats, even though these files are not well suited for open exchange. The first AutoCAD release was named 'Drafting and Design', however, the application was renamed to AutoCAD in 1984. Although the software became popular as CAD, it is primarily used to create engineering- and architectural-style drawings. However, there are also many CAD users who are not architects or engineers. AutoCAD is a Microsoft Windows program that runs on Intel x86-based computers, and Mac OS X systems. The standard release of AutoCAD is an updatable application that is available on discs or as a download in the computer store. AutoCAD Product Key LT AutoCAD LT (a registered trademark of Autodesk, Inc.) is a lower-cost version of AutoCAD that is targeted towards desktop publishers, engineers and other CAD users who do not need the high level of CAD modeling features. AutoCAD LT is designed for the creation of two-dimensional drawings, drawing parts, and printing. It includes the standard drawing and project file formats, including DXF, DWG and DGN, although not all formats are supported by all revisions. There is no CADW or CU-CAD, but there is a version of DWG that is XML-based; this XML-based AutoCAD is labeled CX. AutoCAD LT does not support most of the other Autodesk products, including AutoCAD, other CADG products, software that uses the Autodesk Exchange format, or Autodesk 360. More than 30 people were celebrating a birthday today in the southern French port city of Marseille as they marked their lives with sobriety after years of drug use. But for Paris woman, Hannah, 19, and her mother, the trip was truly a triumphant moment in their journey away from drug use. “I never imagined I’d be here today, I really can’t believe it,” Hannah told AFP, dressed in a red top and jeans, after her release from a Marseille drug rehabilitation centre. “I felt so ecstatic to be alive.” Hannah, who was a regular user of heroin and amphetamines, is one of hundreds of addicts who have found recovery in southern France since a government-sponsored drug prevention centre opened in March. “I was on the way to suicide but thanks to my mother and the doctors who saved me, I have a future,” said Hannah, who used the drugs for 10 years and wants to become a social worker. Just a few weeks ago, Hannah was in the final stages of a detoxification programme at the Centre of Addiction, the first centre of its kind in the country. “Since I came here, I’ve been transformed,” she said, sitting next to her mother, dressed in a black top and jeans. “I don’t even know where to begin to thank the centre for all it did.” ‘I want to have a baby’ The centre’s founders say they are hopeful that their holistic approach, which includes holistic therapy and medical treatment, can help addicts and their families break free from addiction and live normal lives. Hannah and her mother said they had come to the centre after years of being turned away by the “pharmacopoeia”, a term used to describe treatments available to addicts. “We’ve been on the streets for a long time. We couldn’t find the help
