After joining forces with the team behind the popular PDF Creator, Small Bits Studio set its first goal to create the first Android app that really adds value to reading the web-based files. With PDF Creator they already provided a way to convert e-books from the web and save them on the users' device. Now they are doing the same thing for online photo galleries. The idea of TinyImageConverter is to provide a simple tool to reduce the size of your photos or to resize them while keeping the brightness intact. You can apply various filters to the photos and come up with a great looking photo gallery. The gallery is pretty simple but uses a nice and easy to use interface. You just have to click on a specific icon on the lower left corner of the app to choose a gallery to work on. Then you can add up to 2 photo and text file to see the gallery being generated. The available gallery options are: • Full screen list of photos with category and thumbnail • List of photos • Thumbnail of the folder which contains a selected photo • Watermark for the photo • The red-eye correction option is also available • The ability to rotate the photo 90, 180 or 270 degrees. The main tool to work on is a right click menu. From this menu you have the choice to resize photos, zoom in/out, change photo brightness, watermark the photos, change the gallery layout and many more.
